Your proposal to streamline environmental reviews so that road, airport, pipeline, and other projects can be fast-tracked is not consistent with NEPA.

Some of the unacceptable proposed changes include narrowing the range of actions and projects that would require NEPA review, eliminating the requirement to evaluate cumulative effects, removing conflict-of-interest protections, limiting the obligation for agencies to obtain necessary information, and allowing actions to take place before the NEPA process is completed.

In 1969, the 91st Congress enacted the National Environmental Policy Act to address the climate crisis that they and the American people foresaw fifty years ago. Now, in 2020, the climate crisis is not a distant problem that may or may not occur it is already upon us.

NEPA regulations cannot be modernized without addressing greenhouse gas emissions and climate change as part of the process.
